HOW DO WE WORK?

Most children inside Syria are currently not attending school. The country's future will therefore heavily depend on the education received by Syrian children outside their home country.

Double Effect

These children are part of Syria's future educated workforce, and therefore part of their country's rebuilding and development.

In addition, schooling of Syrian children in Turkey facilitates their integration and help prevent social exclusion by enabling them to become fluent in Turkish.
