- Empower local communities socially and economically and reduce tensions between – and within – refugee and local communities.

Health & Education

Lebanon

At least 21,000 people benefit from better health and education services.

At least 3,400 children get access to counselling and leisure activities.

Jordan

At least 1,000 people benefit from better access to safe water.

At least 5,000 children get access to counselling and leisure activities.

Kurdistan Region of Iraq

At least 13,000 people benefit from improved health and education services.

Reducing tensions between refugees & local communities

Lebanon

At least 38,000 people are involved in activities enhancing the wellbeing of all members of the community.

Jordan

At least 11,000 people are involved in activities enhancing the wellbeing of all members of the community.

Kurdistan Region of Iraq

At least 17,000 people are involved in activities enhancing the wellbeing of all members of the community.
